Image #4: SIDEWALK CHALK ... OR DRUG BLOCK?

Kids love getting creative ... and so do drug dealers. Recent DEA busts have uncovered brightly-colored and highly-toxic synthetic opioid intended to entice younger users. Looks can be deceiving. Engineered by researchers developing morphine alternatives for pain management, nitazenes are not FDA approved for any legal use. But these fake pills are flooding the market. Looks can be deceiving.
